The beat goes on in Bergen County, New Jersey integrating scattered pieces of Tillinghast into the renovation of Orchard Hill Golf Course.

As we turn into 2011, Bergen County, New Jersey is again busy with renovations on its 5 course stable of golf. This time the 9-hole Orchard Hills Golf Course in Paramus will undergo a major overhaul. Enhancements include 2 new holes, along with 23 new bunkers, new and expanded tee complexes, cart path improvements, drainage and irrigation expansion.

The work, designed by Robert McNeil, ASGCA Associate and principal of The Northeast Golf Company is underway with an extensive tree management program being directed by Downes Tree Service. This will set the scene for McNeil and Turco Golf, who was the chosen golf contractor, to execute the renovations.

The new features will embrace the remnants of some original Tillinghast styling from the 1920's scattered throughout the site, part of an 18 hole layout that would later be developed into Bergen County Community College. Tillinghast designed the renowned Ridgewood CC which is directly adjacent to Orchard Hills.

The course was originally designed as an 18 layout in the 1920's then later reduced to 9holes when the Bergen County Community College was constructed.
